WATER HARVESTING PLANT

The catchment of a water harvesting system was established in the NITTTR Chennai campus comprising drain pipes, filtration, and storage tanks for reuse and recharge. This cost-effective and eco-friendly way to conserve water was initiated by the Department of Civil and Environmental Engineering. The collected water reduces flooding and decreases soil erosion by decreasing the likelihood of runoffs during periods of heavy rainfall.









RENOVATION OF INTERNATIONAL GUEST HOUSE (IGH)

The up-gradation of the International Guest House at the NITTR Chennai resulted in a beautiful renovation yet economical interior design initiative. The objective of providing a comfortable stay to the international delegates was conducive to a happy learning climate. COVID 19 TESTING INITIATIVES

The RT-PCR test is termed as a highly sensitive technique for the detection of Covid 19. As responsible citizens, the faculty, staff, and contract employees of the Institute attended the testing camp sponsored and conducted in collaboration with Greater Chennai Corporation (GCC).

CIVIL LAB RENOVATION



The testing equipment, following relevant Standards, are essential for components of the Civil Engineering curriculum. The Institute's Civil and Environmental Engineering offers complete laboratory installations for hands-on practice to the M.E. students. This lab is equipped with state-of-the-art facilities in physical testing.



INTERNATIONAL GUEST HOUSE CONSTRUCTION IN FULL SWING

Since the early 1980s, the Institute is offering international programs affiliated to the ITEC scheme of the Ministry of External Affairs (MEA). By improving the hospitality and staying experience for the international delegates, our international training programs will receive more patronage from foreign embassies and delegates.



Considering the limited capacity of the incumbent guest house, the new international guest house was inaugurated in 2019. The recent unlock guidelines have helped the project to become more resilient from the Covid lull to a full swing construction zone. Periodic quality inspections are carried out by the Institute Officials. The construction works adhere to the Covid guidelines for social distancing and mask-wearing.


