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
#### **JANUARY 2021**

The VR modules for Architectural Use Cases and Demonstrations, Engineering and Construction (AEC), Automobile, and Product Design engaged the Civil Engineering Department's PG students in the Infrastructure Engineering and Management course. AR Experiences using mobile devices and tablets was a great learning experience for students. Around 40 Ground Instructors from Air Force Station, Tambaram visited and had immersive experiences using AR/VR technologies. They were fascinated by the scope of simulations and 3D experiential learning features offered by the virtual modules.

#### **AIR FORCE WING COMMANDERS VISIT**


