Note: (Important Instructions to the Candidates)

- All the shortlisted candidates will be allowed to appear for Both Phase I and Phase II Written exam.
- In Phase I Written exam, merit based top 20 positions will be selected in their category.
- Final Selection list will be identified from the top rankers in Written exam of Phase II with two waitlisted candidates as per the number of post in respective category
- Top ranker in Phase II will be selected for the appointment provided the top ranker should be one among the Top 20 in Phase I.
- In case where more than one candidates have secured equal aggregate marks, tie will be resolved by applying the following methods as similar to Staff Selection Commission, one after another, till the tie is resolved:
 - ❖ Date of Birth i.e the candidate older in age gets first preference.
 - ❖ Alphabetical order of the first name shall be given second preference.
