SYLLABUS AND EXAM PATTERN FOR THE POST OF TECHNICAL OFFICER (PRODUCTION ASSISTANT)

Syllabus:

A. Theoretical Knowledge

1. Fundamentals of Educational Video Production

Stages of production: Pre-production, Production, and Post-production, Basics of script writing, Storyboarding and visual planning for instructional content, Timecoding, Shot lists, Scheduling, Production team structure and roles: Producer, Director, Cameraperson, Sound Engineer, Editor, and Production Assistant

2. Camera and Video Technology

Basic camera types: DSLR, Mirrorless, ENG, Studio cameras, Camera parts and operation – exposure, focus, depth of field, white balance, understanding shot composition, camera angles, and movements, Framing for instructional clarity and multi-camera coordination, Video signal formats (HD/SD, 4K, frame rate, aspect ratio)

3. Audio and Lighting Fundamentals

Types of microphones (lavalier, condenser, shotgun) and their placement, Audio recording levels, monitoring, and synchronization, Basic lighting techniques – 3-point lighting, key/fill/back light balance, Lighting for indoor/outdoor, Chroma key (green screen), and interviews, Troubleshooting common audio and lighting issues

4. Video Production Equipment and Operation

Familiarity with studio control room equipment: video switcher, vision mixer, teleprompter, monitor setup, Operating audio mixers, recording consoles, teleprompters, and camera control units, Equipment handling, Cable management, SDI/HDMI connections, Audio-video interfacing, File management and backup systems during and after shoot, Safety precautions in handling video and electrical equipment

5. Post-Production and Graphics

Introduction to Non-Linear Editing (NLE) systems: Adobe Premiere Pro, DaVinci Resolve, OpenShot, or Final Cut Pro, Basics of editing – trimming, transitions, titling, and synchronization, Introduction to graphics and animation tools – Adobe After Effects, Canva, or Blender for motion graphics, Captioning, subtitling, and accessibility enhancement, File export settings for different platforms (TV, web, mobile, LMS integration: hosting videos on SWAYAM, Moodle, or institutional portals)

6. Emerging Trends in Educational Media Production

Multi-camera live streaming and OBS integration, Al-assisted captioning and speech-to-text tools, Introduction to AR/VR-based educational media, Cloud storage, collaborative editing, and digital asset management, Quality standards for e-learning video production (SWAYAM, NITTTR guidelines)

B. Practical / Skill Areas

- Setting up a complete camera-audio-lighting setup for an educational video shoot
- Demonstrating operation of teleprompter, video mixer, and audio console
- Recording a short segment with proper framing and sound quality
- Editing a short clip using transitions, titles, and background score
- Preparing a 10-second animated logo or title card using a web tool
- Exporting the edited clip for web upload with correct compression settings
- Evaluate the ability to identify technical flaws, continuity issues, and quality inconsistencies in video footage
