- If the candidate is absent for any one skill test, he / she is not eligible to take the other two tests. Further, the candidates who have opted driving skill test and absent for any of the skill tests scheduled on 20.06.2026 / 21.06.2026, he/she is not eligible to take the driving skill test scheduled on 22.06.2026 / 23.06.2026. Similarly, the candidates who have opted driving skill test and absent for the driving skill test scheduled on 24.06.2026 / 25.06.2026, he/she is not eligible to take the other two skill tests scheduled on 27.06.2026 / 28.06.2026.
- Requests for change of date and venue for any skill test shall not be entertained.
- Candidates are instructed to report for the skill test on the scheduled date at 08.00 a.m. at NITTTR, Chennai. The skill test may extend to late hours on the scheduled date. Candidates are instructed to plan their travel accordingly.
- To qualify, candidates must score a minimum of 50% of total marks in each skill test. Scoring less than 50% of total marks in any skill test will result in disqualification from progressing to the next stage of the recruitment process.
- Candidates who have opted for Driving skill test must bring a **valid original LMV Driving licence** to attend the Driving skill test, failing which their candidature will be disqualified. Showing the driving licence through photo / e-mail / WhatsApp will not be considered.
- Candidates must bring Hall Ticket and original **valid Photo Identity Proof** with name and date of birth matching the details submitted in the application. Difference in the name and date of birth shall lead to disqualification.
- Hall tickets for the skill test for shortlisted candidates will be uploaded shortly. Candidates are requested to keep visiting the institute website regularly for updates.
- Any further instructions / information will be uploaded only in the institute website. No separate e-mail / post will be sent.
- Any form of malpractice, impersonation, misconduct, or canvassing will lead to immediate disqualification.
- Candidates are advised to maintain discipline, decorum, and silence throughout the conduct of the test.
- Mere appearance in the skill test does not confer any right for selection or appointment.
- Candidates must ensure that all entries made in attendance sheets or other records are correct and complete.
- Candidates are advised not to bring valuables to the test venue. The Institute will not be responsible for loss of personal belongings.
- Candidates shall use only the materials / equipment provided at the venue.
- The decision of the Institute regarding the conduct of the test and evaluation shall be final and binding.
- Candidates are required to comply with all instructions issued by the Institute from time to time.
