To evict the unauthorized occupation in the NITTTR Staff Quarters by Shri M. Rajkumar, Technician (removed from the services on 25.02.2003) and treated as compulsorily retired from service on 22.11.2011 by the Hon'ble High Court of Madras

# Res.No.10-45/2021/BoG

The Board discussed in detail about the unauthorized occupation of NITTTR Staff Quarters by Shri M. Rajkumar since from 01-09-2018. Based on the legal opinion given by the Additional Solicitor General vide his opinion dated 01-02-2021 (Para 3.2.3) action is proposed for filing a Civil Suit for recovery of dues for unauthorized occupation of NITTTR staff quarters from 01-09-2018 onwards.

The Board after detailed discussion, was of the firm view, that not to vacate the NITTTR Staff quarters after retirement without valid approval, is an act of Serious Misconduct.

The Board further directed the Member Secretary to send a draft charge sheet against Shri M. Rajkumar (covering all past issues) to the Ministry of Education, Govt. of India for obtaining the approval from the competent authority.

The Board directed the Director, NITTTR Chennai to stop the pension of Shri M. Rajkumar henceforth i.e. payable for the month of April 2021 onwards by quoting the Rule 8 of CCS

(Pension) Rules 1972 as "future good conduct shall be an implied condition of every grant of pension and its continuance"

As per the direction of the Board, full amount of pension will be stopped to Shri M. Rajkumar payable for the month April 2021 onwards and also a detailed charge sheet against Shri Rajkumar will be sent to the Ministry of Education at the earliest.

#### Item No. 11

To consider and approve the proposal of availing rent free and furnished accommodation, and extending other facilities to the Director, NITTTR Chennai at par with the Director, NITTTR Bhopal, Director, NITTTR, Kolkatta and other Govt. of India Institutions, funded by the Ministry of Education

#### Item No. 12

Directly recruited Associate Professor (pre-revised Assistant Professor) those who not completed Ph.D.within seven years – Acquired Ph.D subsequent dates Hon'ble Supreme Court Order dated 02-02-2021

#### Res.No.12-45/2021/BoG

The Board elaborately discussed this issue and indicated that the Supreme Court order dated 02-02-2021 has aroused out of impugned final judgment passed by the High Court Kerala at Ernakulam that too exclusively for faculty members of engineering college, Kerala. Since the Supreme Court order is not in generic, the Institute may follow the regulations on qualifications, experience, recruitment and promotions etc. as per the AICTE Gazette of India Notification F.No.61-1/RIFD/7<sup>th</sup> CPC/2016-17 dated 1<sup>st</sup> March 2019 and subsequent notification/s from the AICTE from time to time. The Committee is also suggested to refer the page No.7 SI.No.5 of the AICTE Gazette of India Notification F.No27-4/AICTE/RIFD/Pay Scale/2018-19 dated 20<sup>th</sup> May 2020.

However, this issue may be referred through the Committee by placing all the AICTE notification before the committee and the recommendations of the committee may be placed in the next BoG for taking action.

#### Item No. 13

#### Confirmation of the respective post to the Faculty Members and a Group A staff – reporting to the Board

The Board went through the proposal and stated that since all the faculties and a Group A staff have successfully completed their probation, they stand automatically confirmed from the date of their successful completion of the probation.
