The Chairman informed the Director to brief about the agenda item placed before the Board. The Director explained in detail about the three new Masters programmes to the Board.

**Item No.1**

**To consider and approve the proposal to start three New Post-Graduate Programmes in the area of Electronics and Communication Engineering, Technology Management and E-Learning Technologies**

**Res. No. 1-43/2020/E. BoG**

The Board went through the proposal to start three New Post-Graduate Programmes, namely,

1. M.E. Electronics & Communication Engineering - Industry Integrated
2. M. Tech. Technology Management
3. M.E. E-learning Technologies

The Board resolved to approve the submission of the proposal to the AICTE for the three new PG programmes affiliated to the Anna University.

However, the Board directed that the approval for the commencement of the programmes during 2020-21 or 2021-22 will be considered only after submission of the financial and operational aspects discussed which were as follows:

- Fees payable to NITTTR Chennai and Anna University by the students
- Fellowships to be awarded to the GATE Qualified students
- Payment to the Adjunct Faculty to be engaged for this purpose
- Cash flow in terms of income and expenditure
- Managing the programmes with the existing infrastructure and faculty

The Board informed that these aspects may be placed before the forthcoming Meeting for approval for the commencement of the programmes either in the current or next academic year.
